Regional Intellectual Property Policy and Technology Transfer Protocol Review

April 30, 2024

CSU, Butuan City, Agusan del Norte

Rationale

Devising an overarching strategy for IP protection is requisite for a growing innovative ecosystem. An increase in patent applications has been observed in recent years even among State Universities and Colleges (SUCs). This trend signifies initial success or comprehensive enforcement of IP laws among users, beneficiaries, and system administrators.

The focus of SUCs revolves around producing innovative research and moving it toward commercialization. Enhancing local IP laws and policies warrants significant attention from authorities and designated individuals. A review of IP policies and technology transfer protocols is timely to align with updated international and national IP regulations. It also involves integrating local knowledge for national development. This is important in ensuring the exclusive rights of the scientists, inventors, artists, and other talented individuals to their creations, as emphasized in Republic Act No. 8293 (The Intellectual Property Code of the Philippines), where the use of IP serves a social function. In essence, recognizing the social function of IP underscores that these rights aren't solely about private ownership but also about contributing positively to the advancement and welfare of society at large.

Objectives

A *Regional IP Policy and Technology Transfer Protocol (TTP) Review Workshop* will be conducted to assess the current policies and practices related to intellectual property (IP) management of the participating CMI. Specifically,

- review and analyze the existing policies related to IP Management;
- explore techniques for reviewing IP and TTP;
- develop recommendations for improving existing policies and practices related to IP management;
- increase the knowledge and understanding of participants on the innovative policy mechanisms, strategies, and challenges of IP management, the role of IP management in technology transfer; and
- strengthen regional collaboration through complementary IP policies and TTP.

Expected Output:

In connection with the workshop objectives, the expected outputs of the said activity are as follows:

1. reviewed IP Policy and TTP;
2. proposed complementary regional IP policy and TTP; and
3. capacitate participants on reviewing IP Policy and Technology Transfer Protocol.
