



# Course Title: Public-Private Partnership (PPP) for Infrastructure and Development Projects of State Universities and Colleges (SUCs)

**Course Overview:** This course is designed to provide participants with a foundational understanding of Public-Private Partnership (PPP) frameworks as applied to infrastructure and development projects in State Universities and Colleges (SUCs). It will cover key concepts, legal and regulatory frameworks, project identification, feasibility assessment, and the role of PPP in enhancing the infrastructure landscape and development of SUCs.

## **Course Objectives:**

- 1. To introduce participants to the concept and importance of PPP in the context of infrastructure and development projects of SUCs.
- 2. To familiarize participants with the legal and regulatory framework governing PPP projects in the Philippines, particularly in the education sector.
- 3. To provide insights into the process of project identification, feasibility assessment, and selection in PPP initiatives for SUCs.
- 4. To discuss financing mechanisms, risk management, and implementation strategies specific to PPP projects in SUCs.
- 5. To analyze case studies and best practices of successful PPP projects in SUCs and higher educational institutions globally.
- 6. To equip participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to engage in PPP initiatives in pursuing smart campus development and other viable projects anchored on their Land Use Development and Infrastructure Plan (LUDIP).

Duration: Modules 1 and 2 will be conducted for two consecutive days. Sessions will be held in person/face-to-face in Manila.

#### Module 3: Case Studies and Best Practices

- Analysis of successful PPP projects in the Philippines and higher educational institutions abroad
- Lessons learned, key success factors, and challenges encountered
- Replication potential and scalability of PPP models in SUCs infrastructure and development projects

## Module 4: Project Identification and Feasibility Assessment

- · Criteria for identifying priority infrastructure projects in SUCs
- Feasibility studies and project appraisal methodologies
- Socio-economic and educational impact assessment

Duration: Modules 3 and 4 will be conducted for three consecutive days. Sessions will be held in-person, or depending on the prevailing circumstances and participant preferences.

## Module 5: Financing Mechanisms for SUCs PPP Projects

- · Financing options for SUCs infrastructure projects: financing and economic models
- · Financial structuring and risk-sharing arrangements
- Role of multilateral institutions, development banks and other financial institutions, and private sector stakeholders in PPP financing for SUCs

## Module 6: Risk Management and Implementation Strategies

- Risk identification, allocation, and mitigation strategies in PPP contracts for SUCs
- Insurance mechanisms, guarantees, and contingency planning
- Capacity building and institutional strengthening for effective PPP implementation in SUCs

Duration: Modules 5 and 6 will be conducted for three consecutive days. Sessions will be held in-person, or depending on the prevailing circumstances and participant preferences.

## Module 7: Role of Stakeholders and Community Engagement

- Engagement strategies for government agencies, SUCs, private sector partners, students, faculty, and local communities
- Collaborative decision-making, transparency, and accountability in PPP projects
- Public awareness and perception management in SUCs PPP initiatives

#### Module 8: Project Design Workshop

- Group exercises and simulations to design PPP projects for SUCs infrastructure and development projects
- · Presentation and peer feedback on project proposals
- Development of action plans for engagement in PPP initiatives

Duration: Modules 7 and 8 will be conducted for three consecutive days. Sessions will be held in-person, or depending on the prevailing circumstances and participant preferences.

**Course Delivery:** The course will be delivered through a combination of lectures, group discussions, and workshops, with resource persons/speakers from industry, PPP experts, government officials, and representatives from SUCs. Participants will also have access to online resources, reading materials, and interactive learning platforms to enhance their understanding and engagement.

Target Audience/Participants: This course is tailored for SUC senior leaders/officials, middle-level managers, and individuals involved in infrastructure development, finance, project management, procurement, planning, and end-users.

**Total Duration:** The course will be conducted over eleven days, with each session spanning two to three days. Sessions will be held mostly in person or face to face or depending on the prevailing circumstances and participant preferences. Additionally, participants may be required to prepare an action plan to demonstrate their understanding and application of PPP concepts in the context of SUCs.

**Certification:** Upon successful completion of each session, participants will receive a certificate of participation from PASUC and other partner institutions, recognizing their active participation. Participants who complete the 11-day program will receive a certificate of completion recognizing their proficiency in PPP for infrastructure and development projects in State Universities and Colleges.
