**SUBJECT: OSSEI NATIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOP ON CAMPUS

Greetings of peace and solidarity.

The Organization of Student Services Educators, Inc. (OSSEI) will be conducting the National Training on Campus Journalism to be held on September 26-28, 2024 at the Crown Legacy Hotel, Kisad Road, Baguio City.

Each campus shall send participants, to wit,

School Paper Adviser/s Editor-in-Chief	Evaluation of campus publications (best campus publication, best editorial, best news report, etc.) -Participants are therefore, advised to bring the 3 latest issues of their publications.
Photojournalist/Photo Editor	Photo Exhibit on the theme "Hot and Cold: Visualizing Climate Change" -photos must be submitted on or before September 15, 2024 -photos will be posted in the OSSEI Fb page for online voting -photo specifications will be announced in the OSSEI Fb page

Depending on the availability of funds, the campus may add up to two (2) participants only, provided that they are not graduating students, so they can still serve in the editorial board and staff in the succeeding academic year and should not come from the same section of the paper.

Registration fee is 9,000.00 inclusive of lodging (September 27-28), board (from afternoon snacks on September 26 up to lunch on September 28; costs of board and lodging almost doubled) and conference materials if confirmation of, and payment for, participation are received on or before September 15, 2024. After September 15, registration fee is 9,300.00 and on first-come-first-served basis.

The registration fee of live-out participants or those who opt not to stay at Crown Legacy is 6,500.00 (no dinner and breakfast also).





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Walk-in participants will be given room assignments and materials only after those who have confirmed and paid have been accommodated. It is therefore requested that you confirm and pay before the deadline to avoid any inconvenience. CHED endorsement will be given during the conference, as per communication from OSSEI.



In addition to the training workshop, an evaluation of campus publications will be conducted and certificates will be awarded to the best campus publication, best editorial, best news report, etc. Participants are, therefore, advised to bring the three latest issues of their publications.

Also, there will be a photo exhibit on the theme "Hot and Cold: Visualizing Climate Change." Participants are, therefore, encouraged to submit their photos on or before September 15: one photo only per participant. The photos will also be posted on the OSSEI FB page for online voting for the most popular photo. Certificates will be given to the winners. Details for specifications of photo submissions will be announced on the OSSEI FB page.

The objectives of the annual training workshop are: (1) to provide a more intensive training in campus journalism; and (2) to impress upon the participants the various challenges in campus writing.
