The student performers from San Miguel Campus will also represent the Indigenous People and Students during the Workshop on January 8, 2025.

The General Services Unit is tasked with arranging the transportation of the participants, who will leave at 6:00 AM tomorrow, January 7, 2025. The NEMSU delegation will use the university bus for the whole duration of the two-day activity.

On the following day, **January 8**, the same participants will attend the **Workshop on Philippine Ethnic Music, Dance, and Mime**, which will still be facilitated by the UP Kontra-GaPi. This workshop will be held at the **Caraga State University Library Commons, Ampayon, Butuan City.**
