

CREATION OF THE CONTRACT TERMINATION REVIEW COMMITTEE

FOR INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY (ICT)

PROJECTS



The project "Supply and Delivery of North Eastern Mindanao State University Enhanced University Information System (NEMSU EUIS)" was initiated to improve the university's digital infrastructure in line with its goals for enhanced information management and operational efficiency. This project was awarded to MyBusyBee Inc., with the Notice of Award (NOA) issued on April 25, 2022. Following the NOA, the necessary contract signing and the issuance of the Notice to Proceed (NTP) were promptly completed, officially marking the beginning of the project's implementation.

However, despite these formalities, the contractor, MyBusyBee, Inc., failed to deliver the system within the agreed timeline and in compliance with the specifications outlined in the contract. In accordance with the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) guidelines and Republic Act No. 9184 or the Government Procurement Reform Act, this constitutes a failure in contract performance.

A review committee is hereby formed and constituted to oversee and evaluate the circumstances surrounding the non-delivery, with the following members, composed as follows:

RA 9184 provides that government procurement should adhere to principles of transparency, competitiveness, and accountability. Given the critical importance of the NEMSU EUIS in improving university operations and the failure of MyBusyBee, Inc to meet its contractual obligations, the university was left with no choice but to initiate the termination of the contract. This decision is further supported by the verified report,

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which outlines the details of the contractor's shortcomings and the steps taken by the University to address the situation in compliance with GPBB regulations.

As a result, the termination is not only necessary to ensure accountability but also to safeguard the university's interests, ensuring that resources allocated to this project are utilized effectively, and future procurement processes remain compliant with national laws and policies.

The committee is hereby directed to submit their recommendation the soonest time possible.
