Marcos State University (FEMSU), Amending for the Purpose Presidential Decree No. 1279, Entitled "Merging the Mariano Marcos Memorial College and Northern Luzon State College inti a University, Transferring the College Level Courses of Ilocos Norte Agricultural College and Ilocos Norte College of Arts and Trades into Said University, Providing a Charter for the Purpose and Appropriating Funds Therefor" (*Rep. Barba*).
